U9 Half-ice

- First official year of Novice half-ice
- ► Games were played out of Carelton Ice house (Bytown home arena) and JA Dulude (WEHL Home Arena)
- Some technical difficulties/ Growing pains (Clock at Dulude auto-horn, Training/volunteer/knowledge retention for ½ ice boards, officiating)
- ► Not using boards this year, starting afresh in 2021-2022





Season Re-cap - VP Junior Report

U11

- ➤ Second year of BMHL hard cap (20:60:20), idea being if everyone follows the ratio, no debate, no arguing should balance out.. Didn't work at U11, out of 9 teams 4 or 5 futile, 1 above .500
- ➤ Smallest 2 associations don't have enough teams so end up 1:1:1 or 1:2:1, SE managed a last minute "exception" to the split. Had an agreement to shift the schedule so that weak teams only play weak teams post-Christmas.. failed to ratify.
- This will be an issue when this cohort plays again (2021-2022)

Season Re-cap - VP Risk & Safety Report

- WEHL doubles suspensions at all levels.
- There is an appeal process for the extra suspensions which is presenting your case to two (or more) members of the executive.
- Suspensions were up significantly this year (46 incidents, in addition to non-suspendable misconducts).





Season Re-cap - VP Risk & Safety Report

- Novice 1 suspension, Peewee 4, Bantam 10, Midget 30, Juvenile 1
- 14 for slashing/checking, 9 fighting,
 9 match penalties/gross misconduct,
 5 for verbal abuse of referees
- In their 3rd year, online PRC's continue to be a success.
- ► 100+ coaches, assistants, managers and Trainers received their PRC's this year.





Season Re-cap - VP Ice Report

- Report on Past season (2019-20) and Ice related issues
 - Black out days reporting worked very well = not many reschedules were required
 - All teams received at minimum their share of ice (average 2hr per week)
 - Ice Allocation on budget

- Next season (2020-21)
 - Cost of ice has been increased by ~4.5% (\$205.50 per hour)
 - ▶ Budgeting for 2 hours of half ice per week for each team same
 - Covid restrictions in place increasing cost per ice per player
 - Covid measures forcing us into traditional Nepean arenas





Season Re-cap - VP Development Report

Development Programs

- Subsidized
 - ► Clinics: \$4,367 -
 - Pre-season: Had evals on-ice run by NextGenHKY and evaluations assisted by NextGenHKY - generally positive on the on-ice protion, feedback on the eval assistance was mixed.
 - Pre-Season every player was assigned a specific practice jersey, meant for less convenor workload with regards to pinnies
 - Goalie: GAA Thursday Belldome Average weekly attendance up significantly Volunteer shooter policy - to be evaluated
- Cost-Recovery
 - Player: NextGenHKY Wednesday Belldome Program

- ► 2018-19 Season Audit
 - Loss of \$4.7k at April 30, 2019
 - > \$3.3k budgeted / 0.2% variance
 - Information return filed
- ► 2019-20 Season (unaudited)
 - Revenue \$692k (projected)
 - Expenses \$688k (projected)
 - Revenue and Expenses lower
 - Pandemic cancelled year end celebration activities / expenses

2020-21 Budget Overview

- Projections
 - ► Revenue of \$354k
 - Expenses of \$361k
 (Excludes Golden Knights ice)
- Approximately 630 players (70%)
- ► No evaluations and referee expenses
- \$600 fee for both halves of the season
