Games and practices schedules

- WEHL purchases ice from the city for the entire season
- BMHL defines an overall plan for when games will be scheduled
- BMHL is trying to make the schedule consistent and predictable for the season
- BMHL uses ice from all the district allocations and shares the schedule
- BMHL usually provides 2 4 weeks' worth of schedule
- WEHL takes the unused ice and allocates it to teams for practices

WEHL cannot provide practice schedules until BMHL allocates games.



Tournaments

Tournaments Frequency Policy

- U9 max 3 tournaments plus Year-end Fun day
- U11-U18 max 3 tournaments during BMHL sched.
 - One more tournament outside BMHL sched.
- You need permission for additional tournaments
- Tournament & Reserved Dates
 - Email your potential tournament dates ASAP to <u>vp.ice@westendhockey.com</u>
 - Deadlines for reporting tournaments:
 - Sep 30: tournaments before Nov 15
 - Oct 18: tournaments before Jan 1
 - Nov 25: tournaments before Feb 20
 - Feb 3: tournaments overlapping with playoffs

Tournaments greatly impact games scheduling so the earlier we know about them, the less disruptive it will be.

- All volunteers, Coaches, Trainers and On-Ice Helpers require a PRC.
- PRCs are valid for 3 years.
- You require a letter from the VP Risk and Safety which will result in the waiving of the standard fee (\$67.00 for Ottawa police).
- When complete, PRC's need to be forwarded to the VP Risk and Safety.
- Shared birthdate with someone with a conviction may require fingerprinting. We can provide a letter for that as well.



Certifications



Qualifications:

- Need to complete or update required clinics
- Pre-Approval from Level VP/Convenor

Process:

- 1. Go to HEO website: www.hockeyeasternontario.ca/
- 2. Register for a clinic
- 3. Submit WEHL Expense Reimbursement Form with proof of completion
- 4. Processed monthly with accountant takes roughly four weeks to turn around.

Green arm band initiative



- Green arm band indicates a minor-aged official.
- Abuse of a minor aged-official by an adult will result in a more serious penalty. Minimum 4 games.
- All children deserve a safe environment.



BMHL Suspensions

BMHL adopted the Total Team Management (TTM) reporting system.

- Your email associated with your Hockey Canada account/Team List will be used for access.
- Coaches/Managers must now use this system for entering suspensions, tracking games served for suspensions, and recording affiliations.
- All Misconducts, Game Misconducts, Gross Misconducts and/or Match Penalties in any game (exhibition, league, tournament, playoff) <u>must be entered within 24 hours of the game.</u>
- Please remind your players it is WEHL policy to double all BMHL suspensions at all levels.
- Players/team officials can appeal the additional games imposed by the WEHL, requested through VP Risk and Safety.

6.3 Maltreatment, Bullying and Harassment Protection and Prevention Policy

1. During any hockey activities which are sanctioned by HEO;

2. When the Participant who is alleged to have violated this Policy was engaging in hockey activities;

3. When the Participants involved interacted due to their mutual involvement in hockey; or

4. Outside the hockey environment, where the violation of the Policy has a serious and detrimental impact on another Participant.

- Players should be supervised at all times following the "Two Deep Method" of supervision recommended by Hockey Canada (two adults present together).
- People supervising must have completed either "Speak Out" or the "Respect In Sport" for volunteers <u>and</u> have submitted a PRC.
- Photo Devices are strictly prohibited in change rooms.
- Vaping HEO policies and City of Ottawa smoke-free regulations include no vaping on all municipal properties.





Fair Ice Policy

- Fair Ice means equal ice by position
- Roll the lines, at all times, in all games, no exceptions
- Playing ability does not affect playing time
- By the end of the season all players should have had roughly equal ice time in all different game situations: Power Play, Penalty Kill, end of game, overtime
- Applies to all games (regular season, playoff, exhibition, tournament, elimination, championship)
- There is NO "coaches discretion" rule to play stronger players for the last 2 minutes of any game
- Explain the Fair Ice Policy to all players and parents in your first team meeting





- Make tournament fees, extra practice ice, etc. fees optional, <u>no family should have to pay for additional team</u> <u>activities if they don't want to participate</u>
- Refund any budget surplus directly, don't drain team budget by buying end of year gifts or donating to charity
- Make team votes private (email or Survey Monkey) not by show of hands
- Either collect team fees and put them into a community bank account or pay up front then collect. Community bank account authorization from VP Administration





ALL teams need an official team roster

- Ensure proper catchment
- Proof of age for division placement
- One team per player
- Parent and coaching qualifications
- Required for tournaments
- Absolutely mandatory, or team stops operating





- Get your manager involved IMMEDIATELY
 - Manager meeting coming soon...
- Begin documenting staff ASAP, so we can help!
- Lookup tool to check credentials
- Team list will be submitted to District Registrar for final approval and signature
- Final approved roster will go to Coach/Manager
- Possible uses: intra-team comms, player evals





Identify all staff by Sept.30th

► Submit list template to Registrar by Oct.13th

MINIMUM <u>5 DAY TURNAROUND</u> FOR TEAM LISTS

Changes to team means a new team list





Affiliations

- Player can only be affiliated with one team at a time
- Player must be on approved team roster to affiliate
- WEHL will only allow affiliations to fill roster
- Must complete affiliation paperwork, get signatures from parents, both coaches, Registrar. (*sigh.)
- Must obtain permission of coach before playing an affiliate
- Coaches should never deny a development opportunity
- Can only play 10 games for any & all teams as an affiliate
- Players cannot affiliate when their main team is playing
- Emergency Goalie Rule should affiliate a goalie

- Email Shawn Murphy <u>secretary@westendhockey.com</u> for room bookings <u>at Dulude only</u>
- You can book a room for a team function i.e. team meeting, parents meeting, pizza party, Christmas party etc. - the league will cover the cost of the room
- Give enough notice since the City does the scheduling

Jerseys and Equipment (1)

- Equipment Manager & Goalie Equip Manager Mike Moffat
 - equipment@westendhockey.com
 - goalieequipment@westendhockey.com
- Manager or Coach to sign out and inspect jersey sets
 - Pickup sessions will be organized by division before draft dates
 - Deposit cheques for each jersey <u>set</u> for \$100 post dated to April 1st, 2023
 - Avoid issuing jerseys until after balancing!
 - Collect \$40 deposit cheques (post dated to April 1st, 2023) from each player for <u>each</u> jersey
 - All jersey <u>sets</u> need to be returned washed at end of year, with each jersey hung on a metal hanger.





Jerseys and Equipment (2)

Goalie Equipment

- U6/U7: has designated bags already made up.
- ► U9: Each team receives a set
- U11-U18: based on request to the goalie email
- Each team will receive WEHL pucks
- Two pairs of socks for all players
- First Aid kits and water caddies optional return promptly at the end of the season



3rd Jersey Policy

Coaches and/or Team Managers are required to advise the WEHL Board of Directors by email of any intention to purchase team jerseys

- Any WEHL team purchasing an alternate jersey is <u>permitted</u> to purchase a single set of jerseys only. A home set (white) OR away set (dark) but not both.
- Any WEHL team purchasing third jerseys must do so with team funds as generated by fundraising activities or through team sponsorship
- Third jerseys may be worn for any exhibition, league or playoff games between a WEHL team and an external team (within or external to District B). They may also be worn during any tournament games, with the exception of any WEHL sponsored tournaments.
- New Eval Jerseys can be used as 3rd jerseys.
